Today, the Gospel confronts us with a decisive truth: Christ does not want to occupy just a place in our lives; He wants to be the center of our lives. That is why He says: "Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me" (Mt 10:37). Jesus did not come to become one interest among many others, nor to be an occasional reference point in certain moments of life.

At the same time, it is not acceptable for Him to be seen as just another aspect of our life, for He is its foundation, its meaning, and its destiny. The true disciple does not fit Christ into his life; he builds his life around Christ. Elsewhere, Jesus adds: "What profit would there be for one to gain the whole world and forfeit his life?" (Mt 16:26).

The cross that every disciple must take up (cf. Mt 10:38) represents Christ's own path. Carrying the cross does not mean seeking suffering, but remaining faithful to the Lord when living the Gospel comes at a cost. Whoever follows Christ is already walking the road that leads to the Resurrection. In this way, Jesus teaches us that authentic love has a proper order: it is not a matter of loving our family less, but of loving everyone from God and in God. Saint Augustine of Hippo said, "Love, and do what you will." When God holds first place, everything else finds its proper balance. Moreover, Christ does not command us to abandon those we love, but to choose God's truth whenever human affections try to draw us away from it.

The Lord concludes with a promise: "Whoever gives even a cup of cold water to one of these little ones will surely not lose his reward" (Mt 10:42). Nothing we do for Christ will be forgotten. At the final judgment, what will matter is not who accumulated the most possessions, but who loved the most.


For this reason, the teaching of Pope Leo XIV at the beginning of his pontificate resonates powerfully: "This is the hour for love! The heart of the Gospel is the love of God that makes us brothers and sisters." May the Lord grant us a free and generous heart, so that we may love Him above all things. Amen. Evangelii.net

SŁOWO NA NIEDZIELE

Dzisiaj, słysząc padające z usta Jezusa słowa: «Kto kocha ojca lub matkę bardziej niż Mnie, nie jest Mnie godzien...» jesteśmy nieco skonfundowani. Ale zgłębiwszy nieco te słowa zdajemy sobie sprawę z lekcji, jaką Pan chce nam przekazać: dla chrześcijanina jedynym absolutem jest Bóg i jego królestwo.

Każdy powinien odkryć swoje powołanie – to przypuszczalnie najdelikatniejsze z wszystkich zadań – i wiernie za nim podążać. Jeśli chrześcijanin czy chrześcijanka czują powołanie do małżeństwa, muszą widzieć, że realizowanie swego powołania polega na miłowaniu swojej rodziny tak jak Chrystus miłuje Kościół.

Powołanie do życia religijnego czy kapłańskiego wymaga, by nie przedkładać więzi rodzinnych nad więzi wiary, o ile nie naruszamy tym podstawowych wymagań chrześcijańskiego miłosierdzia. Więzy rodzinne nie mogą zniewolić i zdusić powołania, do którego jesteśmy wezwani. Za słowem “miłość” może kryć się pragnienie zawłaszczenia drugą osobą, które odbierałoby jej wolność umożliwiającą jej rozwój swego życia jako człowieka i chrześcijanina; albo strach przed opuszczeniem gniazda rodzinnego i przed konfrontacją z wszystkimi wymaganiami, jakie stawia życie i z wezwaniem Jezusa, by iść za nim. To o przeistoczenie tej deformacji miłości w miłość wspaniałomyślną i szczerą prosi nas Jezus, bo jak mówi święty Augustyn: “Chrystus przybył, by przeistoczyć miłość”.

Miłość i przyciągnięcie zawsze będą jądrem życia chrześcijańskiego, obejmująca wszystkich, a szczególnie, obejmująca członków naszej rodziny, bo zazwyczaj są nam najbliżsi i są również tym “bliźnim”, którego mamy, zgodnie z prośbą Jezusa, kochać. W przyciągnięciu innych zawarte jest zawsze przyciągnięcie Chrystusa: «Kto was przyjmuje, Mnie przyjmuje» (Mt 11,40). Powinniśmy więc zobaczyć Chrystusa w tych, którym służymy i rozpoznać tym samym Chrystusa służebnego, w tych, którzy nam służą.

Episode 3: The Hour of Our Death: Focuses on the spiritual and practical preparations for end-of-life, the sacraments, and navigating the dying process as a Christian.

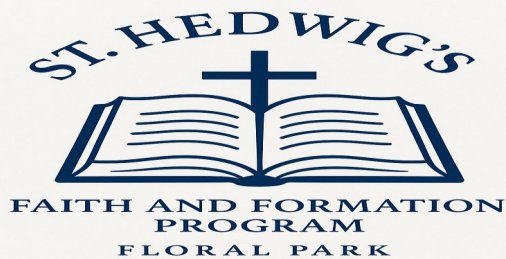
Episode 4: The Faithful Departed: Looks at how the living can care for the body and soul of the deceased through grief, funerals, and prayer.
